



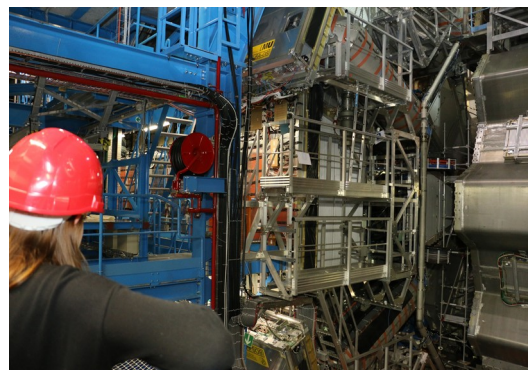
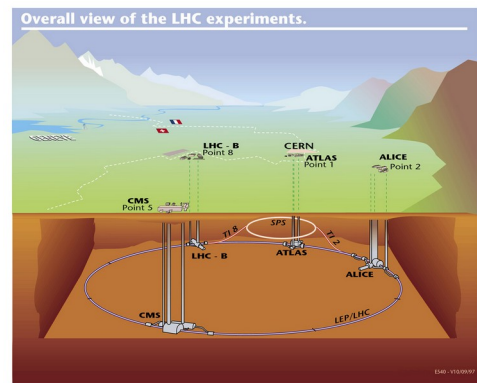
Excursion to CERN
