

Rules of conduct for the Masterlab to protect against Covid-19 infections in

Arrival to the lab

- The 3G rule applies to this course! Please have always with you the proof of immunity (vaccinated or recovered) or a certified negative test certificate.
- Participation is only allowed for people free of symptoms. Students should not join the experiment if they are sick or temporarily feeling unwell.
- Masks are mandatory in the lab (medical or FFP2 masks)
- Go directly to the lab or meeting point.
- Immediately after entering the room, wash your the hands carefully and dry them.

During the experiment

- During the preliminary discussion with the tutors and during the performance of the experiment, both standing and seated, always try to keep a safe distance from each other: preferably at least 1.5 m.
- Disposable plastic gloves can be used.
- It is recommended that the lab room is ventilated regularly
- To sneeze or cough, go to the corridor, use a tissue or cough in the crook of your arm, and then wash your hands. If needed, leave the room quickly for a few minutes and ventilate it.

Leaving the lab

- Ensure you leave the experimental setup and room as it was at the beginning. Ventilate the room and then close it.
